



Prior-Experienced Individuals Training Access Information for Producers

This form explains what Producers need to know about enrolling Prior-Experienced Individuals (PEIs) in their required training courses, receiving proof of training compliance, and how PEIs can ultimately apply for placement on the Industry Experience Roster (IER).

What do I need to know?

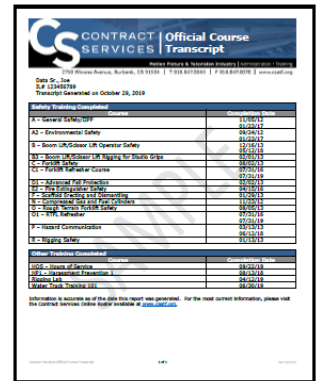
Under the 2021 Producer-IATSE Basic Agreement, the Producers and the IATSE agreed to establish training requirements for **"Prior-Experienced Individuals" (PEIs)** who may be assigned to work on a production. PEIs must complete the Safety Pass "A" Course (General Safety) and Harassment Prevention Training Course (HP1) *before commencing work*. Under the Return to Work Agreement, they must also complete COVID-19 Prevention Training (C19). In general, days worked as a PEI count toward placement on the IER.

How do I obtain access to training for a PEI?

To enable PEIs to access their required training courses, Producers must contact Associate Director of Operations, Jennifer Aguilar at jaguilar@csatf.org or 818.565.0550 ext. 2054. You will need to provide the PEI's name and email address, and we will then send the PEI a link to a *Training Access Request Form* that the PEI can complete online. Based on the information the PEI provides, we will create a Portal Account (available at portal.csatf.org) where the PEI will log in to complete their online training.

How will I know that the PEI completed their training?

Through their CS portal account (portal.csatf.org), PEIs will have access to an **Official Course Transcript** that shows their course completion record. PEIs can use their transcript to demonstrate their training compliance. They can also email a copy of their transcript to any email address from within the portal. (*Important: PEI training records are not publicly available online, so you will need to ask them to send you a copy of their transcript to verify training completion.*)



Can PEIs apply for placement on the Industry Experience Roster?

Yes. Days worked as a PEI count towards placement on the IER in the classification for which they have worked as a PEI. Each classification has its own roster placement requirements, which generally include: a completed Roster Application, proof of a sufficient number of qualifying days worked, and completion of the three training courses detailed above (A, HP1, and C19). Some classifications have additional requirements, such as completion of a color vision test and/or submission of appropriate licenses(s), certificate(s), etc. PEIs will need to satisfy all requirements to be placed on the IER.
